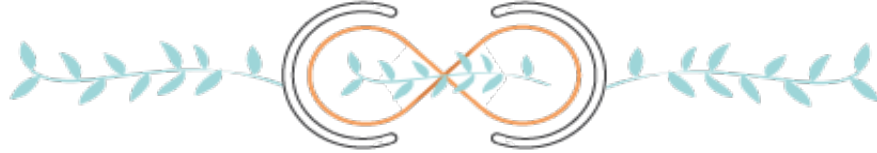

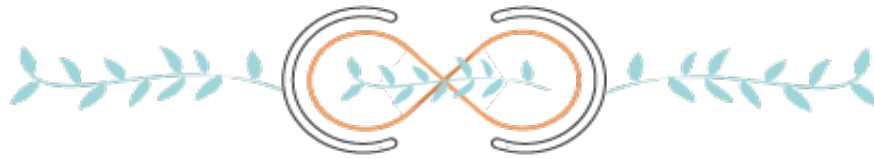

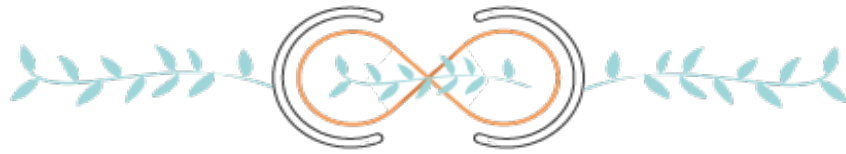

Caitlin always had a smile on her face, a scheme in the making, and laughter in her heart. She graduated from Guilderland High School Class of 2013. Her battle with Type 1 Diabetes and Addison's Disease cut her life short while she was studying nursing as a freshman at SUNY Brockport. She was a chatterbox; friendly, full of energy, stubborn and silly. At eighteen, Caitlin was wise beyond her years and sought out for her attentive listening skills and off-the-cuff no nonsense advice. She loved a challenge, thinking outside the box and was always up for adventures. Above all else, Caitlin let her intuition and mischievous giggle guide her on all things.

She was most herself when hanging out with friends in Lake George or spending time relaxing with her family and her dogs - two labrador retrievers named Bluebell and Maggie. She enjoyed cooking, oystering, clamming, and sailing on the waters of Cape Cod. While at Guilderland she was a Peer Mentor to freshmen students and a member of the Red Cross Club. We continue to celebrate her unmatched capricious spirit in a way she would want us to, by giving back to Guilderland students who are pursuing degrees that will eventually lead to a long career of care and compassion.
